I have dedicated all my life from youth, to serve the community through church activities. I have been involved in Community development programs for many years as an activist in politics and in the church. I registered an NGO called Tembisa Care Centre as a community based organisation, focusing in community development programs for the past 12 years. We have developed close ties with National Youth Development Agency to tackle challenges that our today's youth are faced with; to implement programs aimed at improving lives and opportunities available to young people who are disadvantaged.

For the past 12 years we have been operating from Endulwini Primary School premises on a lease agreement; operating as Abundant Life Christian Centre and we re-branded into our new name as Tembisa Care Centre. I also founded a church in 2006 which is a fast growing ministry in Tembisa, I was able to raise 15 qualified Pastors who are running branches, and I have a powerful young Pastor whom I raised as my assistant at our mother church.

I am also a lecturer at Emit Leadership Institute in Springs for 5 years, training leaders who run organization in various forms. I have worked very close with the Gauteng Department of Health and Wellness under the leadership of Hon. Nomantu Nkomo-Ralehoko, doing programs called "Khuluma Ndoda" and Mental Health Awareness Campaigns to avoid GBV which has become another pandemic in our country.
