OVERVIEW - MASSIFICATION GRANT

COGTA KZN, through the Accelerated Water Intervention Program (AWIP), made funds available to drill and equip production boreholes in areas across Kwazulu-Natal (KZN) to alleviate the water backlogs experienced in certain areas.

This intervention program initiated by COGTA KZN was developed to assist municipalities with challenges of water through its equitable share received from KZN Provincial Treasury.

Ugu District Municipality (UDM) is one of the Water Services Authorities (WSA) in the Province benefitting from this initiative.

UDM consist of four local municipalities namely:

- 1. Ray Nkonyeni
- 2. Umdoni
- 3. Umzumbe
- 4. Umuziwabantu



OVERVIEW - MASSIFICATION GRANT

uGu District Municipality has been experiencing water supply interruption challenges within the Ray Nkonyeni Operational area due to water infrastructure breakdown at St Helen's Rock Raw Water Pump station. St Helen's had series of breakdowns since beginning of 2021 due to electrical switch gear damage during lightning strike, a week of Eskom load shedding, recent faulty on the duty switch gear unit on High lift pump High Voltage panel and low lift pump breakdown. Infrastructure

COGTA KZN provided funding of R15 300 000.00 through Massification Grant to optimise the Pump station



THE PROJECT - SCOPE OF WORKS

The scope of work for this program included the following:

- Servicing and Repair of 2No. Of High Voltage switch gear Panel for Big High Lift Pumps
- Overhauling of High Lift Pump No.4
- Servicing of High Lift 1,2 and 3
- Overhauling of 4 No. of Low-Lift Pumps while awaiting new Generation Low lift Pumps .
- Supply , delivery and installation of New Generation Low Lift Pumps including Modification of base plates and Housing and new MCC Panels for Low lift .
- Repairs to leaking Bulk Line(900mm)
- Servicing of Lifting Equipment including safety certification of the Lifting Equipment

WORK UNDERTAKEN:

- Switch Gear on High Voltage Panel Completed
- Leaking Gasket completed on 900mm Pumping main
- Lifting Equipment completed
- Low Lift Pumps Overhaul

OUSTANDING WORK:

High Lift No.4 Installation – The OEM to deliver Overhauled Pump on the 30th November 2022 with installation in the 1st Week of December 2022. New Generation Low-Lift Installations- Pumps have been purchased and OEM has had pumps cleared from customs – Installation to commence from 1st December . Pressure testing to be carried out off-site on the 28th November 2022.
